Forty Carrots Receives Grant to Expand Child & Family Therapy Program

December 13, 2016 - Forty Carrots Family Center, a local nonprofit dedicated to strengthening families, will expand its Child & Family Therapy services with the help of a generous three-year grant from the Charles & Margery Barancik Foundation. The grant of \$196,200 will support the growing program, including the addition of a new Clinical Supervisor to ensure that families have access to the best quality of care. Forty Carrots Child & Family Therapy services grew 61% in the last year.

“For some of the families we serve, Child & Family Therapy is an essential part of building a strong foundation that allows children and parents to thrive,” said Michelle Kapreilian, executive director. “The Barancik Foundation is a tremendous partner in helping us meet the remarkable need and to make a difference in young lives.”

Forty Carrots Family Center began offering mental health services to address unmet needs encountered in its Free Community Outreach Program. In addition to mental health groups provided at locations like SPARCC and Salvation Army, Forty Carrots provides Child & Family Therapy individual services. Forty Carrots recently completed a capital campaign adding a reception area, two new therapy rooms and office space for Therapists and an Intake Coordinator.
