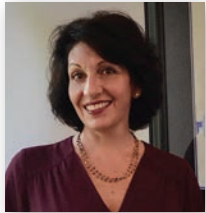
Dear Friends of Forty Carrots,

Our NAEYC-accredited program is held to a rigorous standard and rooted in a play-based curriculum that stirs imaginations and inspires young minds. Our professional, degree-level teachers nurture each child's social, emotional, creative, physical, and cognitive development.

Young students learn positive social interactions - sharing, communicating, cooperating, and caring; self-esteem, self-sufficiency, and feelings of self-worth; cognitive skills; creativity in art, language, music, and critical thinking; enhanced fine and gross motor skills; respect for the world around us; and respect for others.

Early Childhood Education is proven to have a significant return on investment - for the child, the family, and the community in which they live.

Our therapists meet the highest professional and clinical standards and are trained to work with the most vulnerable among us. Addressing the family system is the way to prevent current mental health concerns from taking root and causing long-standing mental health disorders.

We see families struggling with myriad issues like divorce, illness, depression, anxiety; working with teen mothers who were themselves victims of abuse needing to heal from their trauma to become a different kind of parent; homeless families in need of a way to stabilize their family relationships. THE MONTEI FOUNDATION

“Anybody can have a child, but we’re not born knowing how to be great parents. Those formative years are so critical to a child’s development, and Forty Carrots is there for both the children and their families,” said Julia Montei.

The Montei Foundation was established in 2000 in Columbus, Ohio by Julia’s father Tom. Julia became a part-time resident of Sarasota in 2011 and found herself driving by Forty Carrots on a regular basis. She recalls thinking that it looked like such a warm and friendly place. That year Julia did some research, and was thrilled to find that Forty Carrots’ mission matched her mother’s passion. Therefore, it became the first organization in Sarasota that the Montei Foundation chose to support.



“**My mother, Jo Ellen, was all about children.** She was Franklin County’s first welfare agent, went into social work and adopted my brother and I,” Julia said. “She would have loved the programs that **Forty Carrots offers and everything it does for the community.**”





“Regardless of how successful you might be in the workplace, all of that goes out the window when you have children,” said Erin. “I can’t tell you how much Ben and I have learned from the teachers and staff at Forty Carrots about being good parents.”

Ben Jones, president of Allegiant Private Advisors, and his wife, Erin, Vice President, Finance and Operations, Community Foundation of Sarasota County, are parents of two Forty Carrots preschool graduates, Andrew and Lauren.

“We weren’t looking for someone to watch our kids during the day. We were looking for a partner in developing our children, and that’s what we found at Forty Carrots,” said Ben, current Forty Carrots Trustee and Treasurer.

“There are so many spokes on the wheel of what they do for our community – the preschool, their mental health programs and their parenting education. As we became familiar with their programming, and the fact that so many of its services are provided at no charge to those most in need in the community, we knew we wanted to do what we could to help,” Ben added.

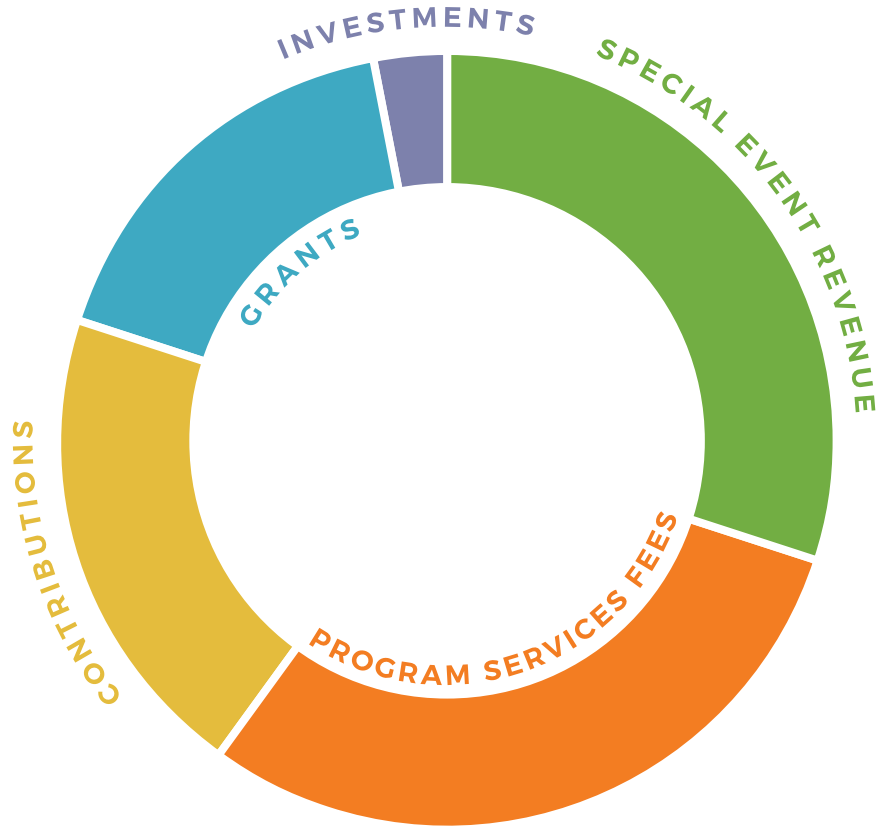

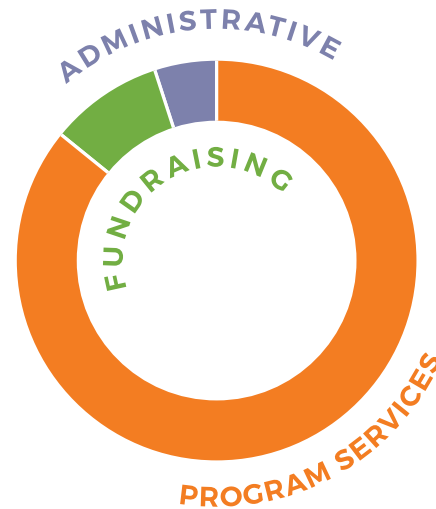
