

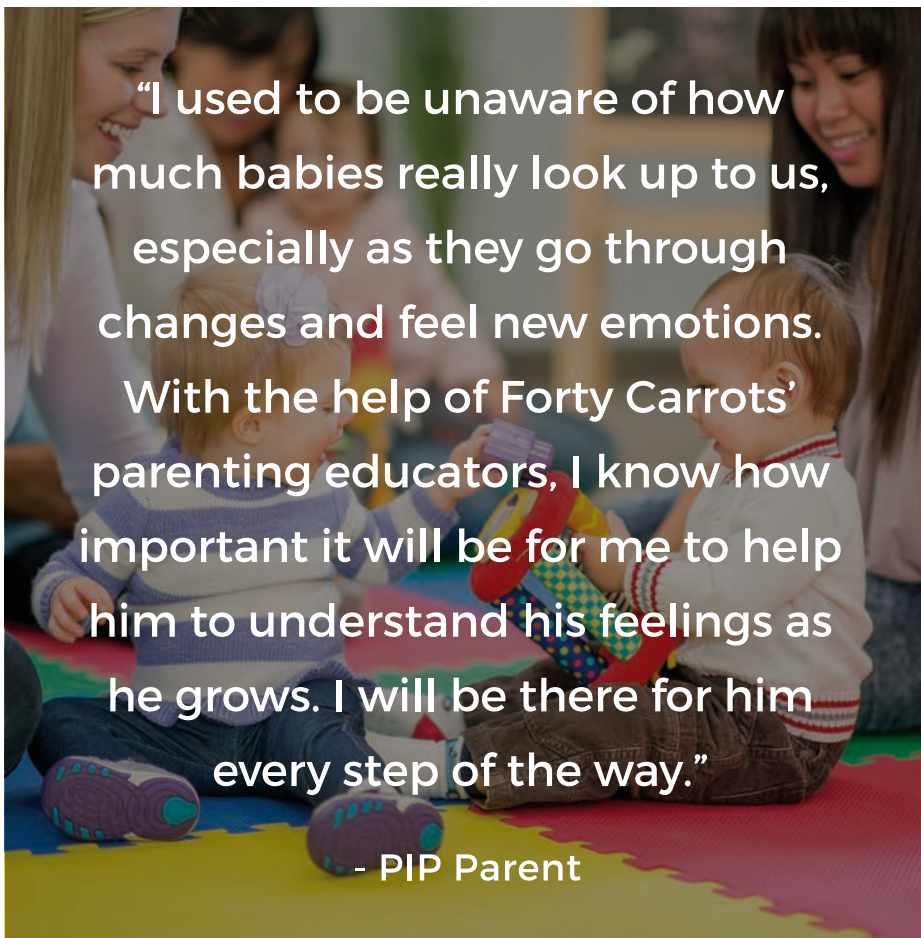

Our Parenting Educators can change the course of a young child's life by providing the tools and resources that parents and caregivers need to create nurturing environments supporting healthy early brain development. These same tools help build strong bonds between a parent and child, thereby preventing child abuse, neglect, and other adverse childhood experiences.

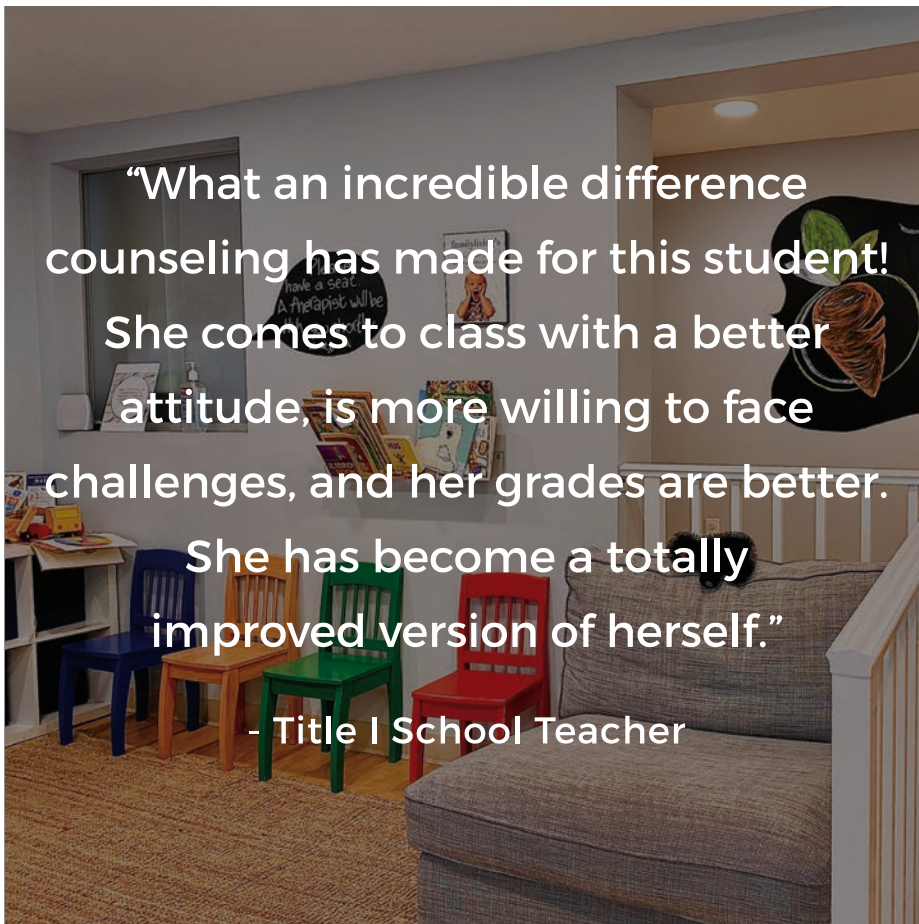

In her quiet way, Eliza Culverhouse sees a need and makes this community stronger for children and families. Each and every day at Forty Carrots, her philanthropic impact resounds through interactions between children and families. From phones ringing and new families being welcomed, to the smiles and gratitude of a scholarship family walking in the door at drop-off. Children singing in the Preschool whose voices would not be in the chorus if not for Ms. Culverhouse's generosity.

Across the street, a father and daughter arrive at the Child & Family Therapy Center. The therapist asks the young girl, what colors she'd like to draw with, and her feelings sprawl across the paper. The father nods in understanding that behavior is communication and when a child acts out, it is a cry for help. This family is learning ways to understand their child's development and cope with mental health concerns.

Eliza's generosity stems from a personal belief in the power of meeting the educational and mental health needs of children and families—the sooner the investment, the greater the return. Amidst all the noise in our everyday lives, Eliza's impact is articulate, clear, and will echo for generations to come.
