FORTY CARROTS FAMILY CENTER'S MISSION is to nurture healthy child and family development through research-based, relationship focused education and mental health services.

OUR GENERATIONS OF CHANGE CAMPAIGN includes a new campus building for sustained program expansions in Mental Health and Parenting Education services. The need for prevention, intervention and treatment services is critical and timely in the face of increasing hardship in our community.

PREVENTING ABUSE, NEGLECT, AND OTHER CHILDHOOD TRAUMAS is done through safe, stable, nurturing relationships for all children. Parenting Education is necessary for preventing future mental health concerns for children. Parents must be aware of the symptoms and behaviors indicating a potential mental health issue at all ages to mitigate severe outcomes. Between 2009 and 2019 suicide rates for youth ages 10 to 24 were up by 57%. We know that the pandemic has increased rates of anxiety and depression. There is a long road ahead of us and quality, accessible services for all is a must.

OVER THE PAST 30 YEARS, FORTY CARROTS HAS GROWN EXPONENTIALLY, serving over 5,000 clients annually. Expanding our Parenting Education and Mental Health services is due to the overwhelming community need and our unique approach to outreach partnerships allows us to efficiently and broadly serve all families, regardless of ability to pay. Currently, 92% of clients receive services at no charge or on a sliding scale.



WITH OVER 30,000 CHILDREN UNDER THE

AGE OF 5 in Sarasota and Manatee Counties, more than 56% of them in low-income homes, it is imperative that Forty Carrots expand our reach and achieve our vision for every child to be raised in homes where they are physically and emotionally safe, have strong, loving and nurturing relationships and surrounded by rich learning environments to grow into responsible, caring, capable young adults.


