

Forty Carrots Family Center's Generations of Change expansion campaign reaches a milestone of raising \$8.5m of a total \$10m for a new campus for expanded Mental Health and Parenting Education services, which is due for completion in Q4 2023.

The new campus includes a new 6,900 sq ft building on 1.72 acres at 1350 Cattlemen Rd. It offers a Child and Family Therapy Center with 6 therapy rooms, intake office, waiting area and Parenting Education Center equipped with flexible capacity with moveable wall and observation capabilities, virtual program rooms, administrative offices, and program staff workspaces. The addition of the Cattlemen campus allows for the expansion of early education services and administrative offices in the existing buildings on S. Tuttle Avenue.

The need for prevention, intervention and treatment services is critical and timely in the face of increasing hardship in our community.

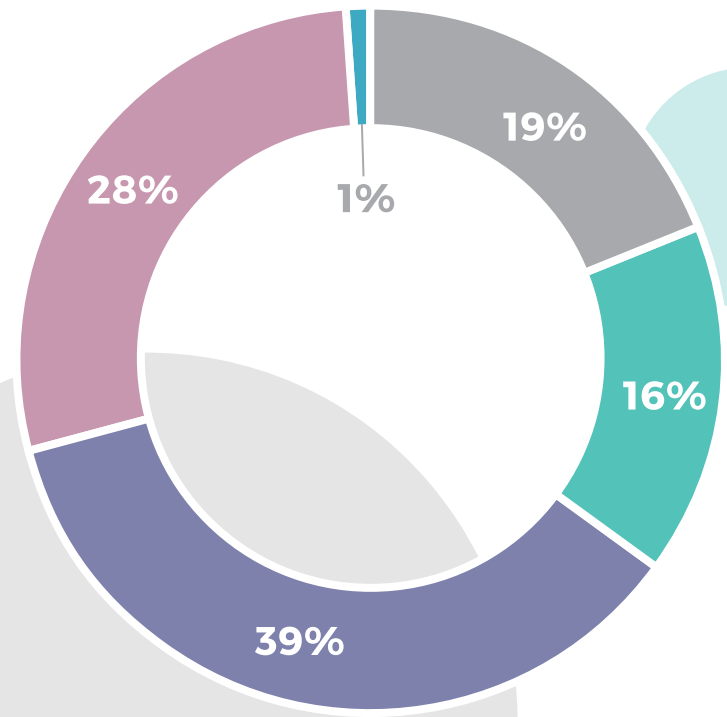
